## HUMANITARIAN ENGAGEMENT & BACKGROUND

FAYA Nepal is actively involved in comprehensive humanitarian efforts within the Sudurpashchim province. It has executed initiatives such as distributing both food and non-food relief items, managing emergency shelter and logistics, and providing support in Health, WASH, and psycho-social assistance. The organization adheres to humanitarian principles and maintains strong partnerships with key stakeholders like Local Government, provincial Government, District Disaster Management Committee, provincial Disaster Management Committee, District Emergency Operation Center (DEOC), Provincial Emergency Operation Center (PEOC), as well as various clusters including Food Security, Health, Education, Protection, Shelter, and WASH in Kailali district and it has a strong network in district, Province, National and International level. FAYA Nepal serves as a provincial coordinator and national board member for Disaster Preparedness Network Nepal (DPNet). Additionally, it is a member of organizations such as NEAR, GNDR, and Charter for Change. FAYA Nepal has effectively executed a range of humanitarian projects, supported by various donors.

## INTRODUCTION

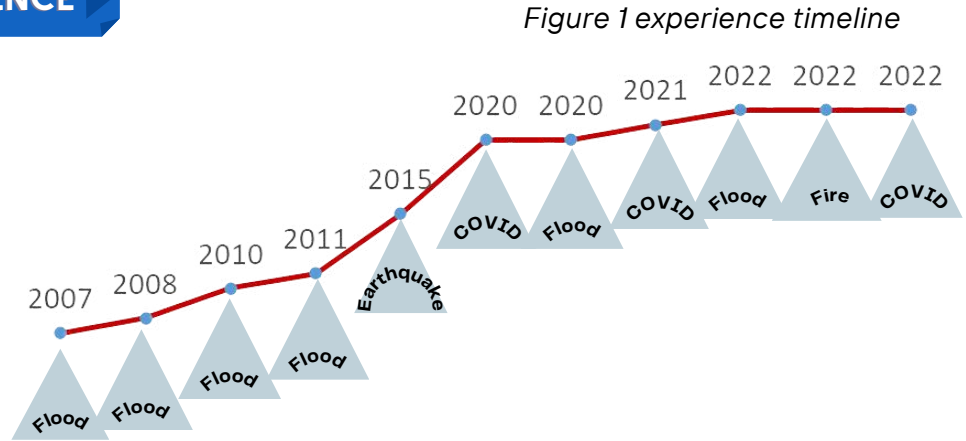

## FUNDRAISING AND RESOURCE MOBILIZATION

FAYA Nepal understand the critical role of sufficient funding to facilitate effective emergency responses. The organization upholds a permanent reserve fund of NPR. 200,000 and actively participates in fundraising endeavors. We consistently explore diverse funding channels, including social media appeals, email campaigns, text-to-donate initiatives in dedicated accounts, peer-to-peer fundraising, corporate partnerships, utilization of emergency toll-free numbers, collaboration with NGOs and International Aid agencies, and applications for emergency grants from organizations supporting disaster relief efforts. The mobilization of emergency fund in accordance with the guideline for fund mobilization. We also have stockpiled NFI materials for 20 HH.
